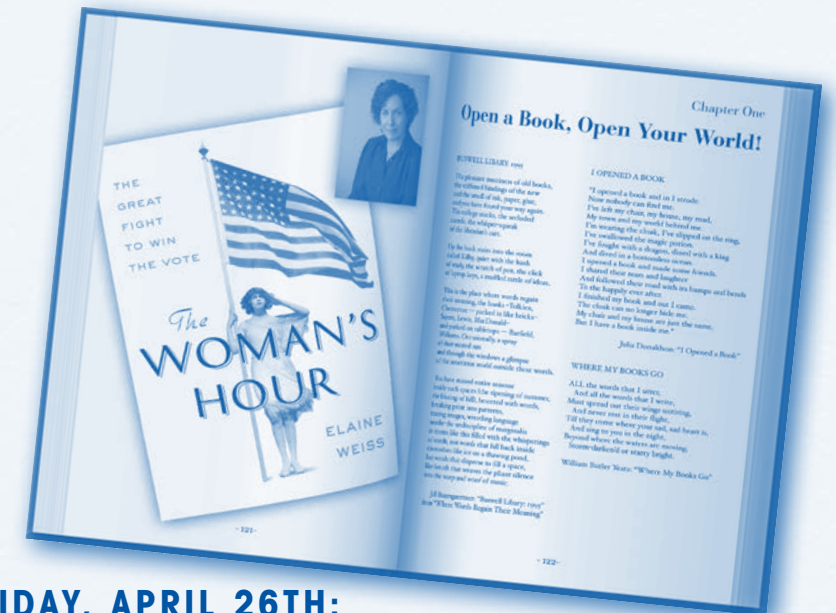

**OPENING NIGHT Elaine Weiss:** Our 2019 honoree is award-winning journalist and writer Elaine Weiss. In her stirring, definitive, and engrossing treatment of suffrage in America, *The Woman's Hour: The Great Fight to Win the Vote*, Weiss tells the story of American women's long crusade to obtain that most basic right of democracy—the vote—and the forces of history, culture, and politics which made their quest so difficult, including the racism that came very close to defeating the cause. *The Woman's Hour* is a fascinating read about a challenging time and the perfect example of how compelling and relevant history can be. This event **begins at 6:00p.m.** at the **Firehouse Center for the Arts** and is free to the public. Seating is on a first-come basis.
